NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Ohio Casino Control Commission on Monday, April 2, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. on the 6th Floor of the One Columbus Building, located at 10 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the following proposed rules:

Rule 3772-4-10, titled "Standards for contractors of casino operators." The proposed rule sets forth requirements pertaining to contractors utilized by the casino operators.

Rule 3772-4-11, titled "Computation of gross casino revenue; assisting the tax commissioner." The proposed rule requires the casino operators to be in compliance with section 5753. of the Ohio Revised Code.

Rule 3772-9-08, titled "Movement of electronic gaming equipment within a casino facility." The proposed rule establishes procedures when moving electronic gaming equipment in a casino facility. Further, the rule details required information to be recorded in a log.

Rule 3772-9-09, titled "Removal of electronic gaming equipment from the casino facility's gaming floor." The proposed rule details the procedure required when removing electronic gaming equipment from the casino floor.

Rule 3772-9-10, titled "Electronic gaming equipment maintenance, repair, or other servicing standards." The proposed rule outlines the requirements the casino operator is to follow when maintenance, repair, or other servicing standards are performed and what information shall be kept in a log.

Rule 3772-9-11, titled "Remote systems access." The proposed rule sets forth the procedures for accessing gaming systems remotely, when they can be accessed, and who can access them.

Rule 3772-10-08, titled "Slot machine meter readings and related statistical reports." The proposed rule requires the casino operators to include internal controls for meter readings and preparation of other statistical reports. Further, the rule establishes procedures to follow when taking meter readings or other statistical reports.

Rule 3772-10-23, titled "Credit." The proposed rule specifies the requirements to follow for a licensed casino operator to extend credit to a patron.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and present oral and/or written testimony. Written comments may also be submitted to the attention of Matthew R.
