

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 15, 2021, at 1:00 p.m., in Room 1, Level 2, 30 West Spring Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, to consider the following rules as summarized below:

Amending:

4123-19-03 Where an employer desires to secure the privilege to pay compensation, etc., directly.

4123-19-06 Procedures for revocation of self-insuring status.

4123-19-09 In regard to complaints filed by employees against self-insuring employers under the provisions of section 4123.35 of the Revised Code.

4123-19-16 Self-insured construction projects.

BWC has identified and is proposing several changes to Chapter 4123-14 rules in response to the Common Sense Initiative Office (CSI) initiative encouraging state agencies to remove references to outmoded means of communication and in-person interaction from their rules where appropriate.
