

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
to rescind rules 4501-33-01, -02, -03, and -04,
and to adopt new rules 4501-33-01, -02, -03, -04, -05, and -06
of the Ohio Administrative Code in accordance with
Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code

The Ohio Department of Public Safety will conduct a public hearing pursuant to R.C. 119.02 through 119.04 on July 6, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Room 109, Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the following proposed rules to the Ohio Administrative Code:

Based on a five-year Ohio Revised Code Section 119.032 rule review, and as authorized in Section 5502.011 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Department of Public Safety proposes to **rescind rules** 4501-33-01, -02, -03, and -04, and to **adopt new rules** 4501-33-01, -02, -03, -04, -05, and -06 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The four existing rules of OAC Chapter 4501-33 (4501-33-01 through -04) were adopted under the procedures of section 111.15 of the Revised Code and are being proposed for rescission and re-adoption as new rules under the procedures of section 119.03 of the Revised Code. Two new rules (4501-33-05 and -06) are also being proposed for adoption to further clarify inspection criteria for salvage and self-assembled vehicles.

Together, the proposed rules of OAC Chapter 4501-33 set forth the procedures for application, the requirements for evidence of ownership from applicants for, and the extent of inspection by the state highway patrol of a motor vehicle assembled from component parts by a person other than the manufacturer as provided in section 4505.111 of the Revised Code and of a motor vehicle titled with a salvage certificate of title and restored for operation upon the highways as provided in section 4505.11 of the Revised Code.

Either written or oral testimony will be received at the hearing. Additionally, written comments received at the address below before the hearing will be treated as testimony.
