## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BOARD OF NURSING HOME EXAMINERS (BENHA)

The Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators (BENHA) will conduct a public hearing beginning at **11:15 a.m. on Thursday**, **September 5**, **2013**, **in the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor "Stripes" Conference Room of the Ohio Department of Health**, **35 E. Chestnut Street**, **Columbus**, **Ohio**, **43215**. The purpose of this hearing is to consider amending the following O.A.C. rules:

- 4751-1-05 Pre-examination requirements; conditions precedent to application for admission to examination;
- 4751-1-06 Subjects for examination; and
- 4751-1-07 Examination and passing grade.

These rules are proposed pursuant Chapter 4751.04 of the Revised Code and have been reviewed to comply with five-year review requirements. The three rules concern the examination a person must pass before being licensed as a nursing home administrator. BENHA is proposing minor revisions in order to adopt gender-neutral, person-centered language; and to clarify language regarding abandonment of application to sit for exam. Stylistic amendments are proposed to O.A.C. rule 4751-1-06, as well.

At the hearing, persons affected by the proposed actions may appear and be heard in person, by an attorney, or both; may present their positions, arguments, or contentions orally or in writing; may offer witnesses; and may present evidence tending to show that the proposed rule, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
