Clarified requirements for continuing education course certificates. Modified to state the NASW continuing education program approvals to be for NASW national and NASW Ohio Chapter only. Modified to more clearly explain post program approvals for continuing education programs.
4757-9-07	Documentation of continuing professional education required for renewal of a license or certificate of registration.	Added new paragraph (D) stating licensees may not attend the same CE course within one renewal period.
4757-17-01	Counseling supervision.	Modified paragraph (F)(2) to reflect changes from 6 to 3 supervision hours for PCC-S licensees.
4757-21-03	Scope of practice for an independent social worker.	Clarifies clinical supervision of SWTs who are providing diagnosis and treatment & LISW supervision versus LISW-S supervision.
4757-25-01	Education requirements for admission to the examination for marriage and family therapist.	Changes the practicum requirements to meet the accreditation requirements under COAMFTE.
