4757-1-07 Discipline actions that may include fines.

4757-1-08 Military provisions related to licensure for counselors, social workers and/or marriage and family therapists.

4757-3-02 Abbreviations and titles.

4757-5-02 Standards of ethical practice and professional conduct: clients/consumers of services.

4757-5-10 Standards of ethical practice and professional conduct: reporting unethical actions.

4757-6-01 Reports prepared for court review including custody, visitation and guardianship concerns. 4757-11-02 impaired practitioner rules.

4757-13-03 Requirements for licensure as a licensed professional clinical counselor.

4757-25-01 Education requirements for admission to the examination for marriage and family therapist. 4757-29-01 Marriage and family therapy supervision.

The public hearing on the proposed actions of the Counselor, Social Worker & Marriage and Family Therapist Board is scheduled for **Tuesday, February 16, 2021**. **The hearing will begin at 11:00 AM via MS TEAMS (Access information is included below)** and from time to time thereafter as may be required by the Board to hear all relevant testimony, oral or written, by any person affected by the proposed action, his/her attorney, or both.
