Pursuant to sections 5104.30, 5104.34, and 5104.38 and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption and rescission of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:2-16-30 "Eligibility requirements for receipt of publicly funded child care benefits" is being proposed for rescission and replaced as new to remove the federal poverty level appendix from rule and simplify the eligibility language. The income standards will now appear in the child care manual as a link allowing counties to implement the annual income standards more quickly, potentially increasing access to publicly funded child care.

Rule 5101:2-16-39 "Copayment for publicly funded child care benefits" is being proposed for rescission and replaced as new to add language regarding reinstatement and to clarify weekly copayments. The appendix to the rule containing copayment amounts is being removed as an appendix and will now be added to the child care manual.
