Pursuant to section 5101.134 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The rule is proposed for amendment as a result of five year review, in addition to communication with internal and external partners regarding the need to allow access to the SACWIS system for Wendy's Wonderful Kids (WWK) recruiters.

OAC rule 5101:2-33-70, entitled "Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System (SACWIS) access" provides guidance to agencies regarding access, use, and training on the confidential information contained within the SACWIS system. Changes are being made to allow direct SACWIS access to workers who are contracted as Wendy's Wonderful Kids (WWK) recruiters for an entity other than the agency that employs them. Paragraph (B) was added to clarify when data may be accessed in the SACWIS system. Paragraph (I)(13) was revised to correct the name of the National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System. Paragraph (N) was added to allow staff who are employed as WWK recruiters for agencies other than the custodial agency to have direct access to the SACWIS system.
