Pursuant to section 5101.1414 and Chapter 119.03 of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment and adoption of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The rules are being amended and adopted to clarify policy relating to the administration of the Bridges program.

OAC 5101:2-50-02, entitled <u>Requirements for bridges eligibility</u>, is being proposed for amendment. This rule provides the eligibility criteria a Bridges applicant must meet to enroll in the program. This rule also contains the steps to apply for Bridges and the denial process. This rule has been amended to expand eligibility pursuant to H.B. 166, and language was added to explain provisional enrollment. Language referencing a Bridges plan was removed.

OAC 5101:2-50-03, entitled <u>Bridges termination and reentry</u>, is being proposed for amendment. This rule provides the reasons a Bridges participant will be terminated from Bridges. This rule also contains the termination and reentry process for Bridges. This rule has been amended to provide clarity on program expectations, and language was added to explain the termination process for provisional enrollment.

OAC 5101:2-50-04, entitled <u>Bridges Title IV-E eligibility and reimbursability</u> <u>determination</u>, is being proposed for amendment. This rule provides guidance on how Title IV-E eligibility and reimbursability are determined for a Bridges participant. This rule has been amended to provide clarity on program expectations, and language was added regarding placement leave statuses.

OAC 5101:2-50-05, entitled <u>Bridges appeal process</u>, is being proposed for amendment. This rule provides the steps individuals will take if they decide to appeal a denial or termination from Bridges. This rule has been amended to provide clarity on program expectations

OAC 5101:2-50-06, entitled <u>Bridges approved supervised independent living settings and</u> <u>visitation requirements</u>, is being proposed for adoption. This rule provides guidance on approved supervised independent living settings and visitation requirements for Bridges.

OAC 5101:2-50-07, entitled <u>Bridges assessment</u>, <u>plan and review</u>, is being proposed for adoption. This rule provides guidance on the process to complete the Bridges assessment, plan and review.

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OAC 5101:2-50-08, entitled <u>Case records for bridges</u>, is bring proposed for adoption. This rule provides guidance on maintaining case records for Bridges.
