Pursuant to sections, 2151.421 and 5153.166 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The following rule is subject to five-year review.

OAC Rule 5101:2-36-14 Protective service alert sets forth the requirements that apply to public children services agency (PCSA) when issuing a protective service alert (PSA) upon receipt of an abuse or neglect report when the whereabouts of a child or his or her parent, guardian, or custodian are unknown and the PCSA has reason to believe the child is in immediate danger of serious harm. Assignment of originating PCSA has been removed from rule to allow any PCSA to document changes to the PSA in SACWIS. Expiration date of the PSA has been changed to reflect one year from the issue date. Extension of the PSA were modified to one year to be consistent with the expiration date of the PSA. Restructuring the order of paragraphs have occurred throughout the rule.
