Pursuant to sections 2151.412, 5101.11, 5153.166 5153.166 and Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC rule 5101:2-45-04 entitled "**Traditional Candidate for Title IV-E Foster Care**" outlines the requirements for a child to be considered a Title IV-E candidate for foster care who has a defined case plan that identifies in-home services to prevent removal, where foster care is a planned arrangement for the child. The Title IV-E agency may claim Federal reimbursement for the allowable administrative costs associated with the case management. The title "Traditional Candidate for Title IV-E foster care" has been amended to reflect "Title IV-E Candidate for Foster Care." A new paragraph (D) was added to provide clarification to documentation requirements for eligible Title IV-E candidates into the Ohio SACWIS system. Title IV-E language was added to provide clarification throughout the rule.
