Rule 5101:2-18-02 entitled <u>Programs that are exempt from being a registered or an approved</u> child day camp has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-03 entitled <u>Requirements for registered child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-04 entitled <u>Application and fee required for approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-05 entitled <u>Inspection of approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, add language for use of an application form and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-06 entitled <u>Issuance and renewal of approval for child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, add a required form and to clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-07 entitled <u>Complaint investigation procedures for approved child day camps</u> had been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-08 entitled <u>Denial and termination of approval for child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, add a provision for suspension and to clarify language regarding termination.

Rule 5101:2-18-12 entitled <u>Requirements for supervision of children in approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-13 entitled <u>Requirements for program activities in approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, define specialized activities and define staff responsibilities.

Rule 5101:2-18-14 entitled <u>Requirements for field trips from approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, clarify language and add requirements for the use of seat restraints in vehicles used to transport children.

Rule 5101:2-18-15 entitled <u>Requirements for health care and medication at approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and to add requirements for medication administration.

Rule 5101:2-18-16 entitled <u>Requirements for administration of medication in approved child day</u> camps has been rescinded. The contents have been moved to 5101:2-18-15.

Rule 5101:2-18-17 entitled <u>Requirements for first aid supplies at approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, add new requirements for the first aid kit and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-18 entitled <u>Requirements for the care of children with special needs at approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-19 entitled <u>Information for parents of children attending approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-20 entitled <u>Requirements for records of children in approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title, add requirements for the written health record and to clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-21 entitled <u>Safety requirements in approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-22 entitled <u>Behavior management for children in approved child day camps</u> has been amended to change the title and clarify language.

Rule 5101:2-18-25 entitled <u>Vehicle safety and driver training</u> has been rescinded and replaced with a new rule with the same number, entitled <u>Vehicle safety and driver training in approved child day camps</u>. The new rule adds additional requirements for the operation and maintenance of vehicles used to transport children and driver training requirements.
