**Rule 5101:2-42-19** entitled <u>Requirements for the provision of independent living services</u> to youth in custody is being proposed for amendment as a result of the five year review. This rule sets forth the responsibility of the public children services agency (PCSA) in assessing youth and providing independent living services for youth that enter into custody at age sixteen or older, with the likelihood that the youth will age out of care. The changes to the rule are to include the new independent living services as outlined by the National Youth in Transition Database (NYTD), so that OAC is consistent with the federal expected outcomes and services.

**Rule 5101:2-42-19.2** <u>Requirements for the provision of independent living services to</u> young adults who have emancipated is being proposed for amendment as a result of the five year review. This rule sets forth the responsibility of the public children services agency (PCSA) in assessing youth that have emancipated and have returned to the PCSA to request independent living services. The changes to the rule include the new independent living services as outlined by the National Youth in Transition Database (NYTD), so that OAC is consistent with the federal expected and services.
