Rule 5101:2-42-09 "Purchased services contract requirement" is amended to reflect the new ODJFS form numbers i.e., JFS 01666 and provide clarification to the wording of the rule.

Rule 5101:2-42-21 "Agency and court interstate placements requirements" is amended as follows: Changes were made to provide clarification to the wording of the rule.

Rule 5101:2-42-67 "Preparation of Lifebook" is amended as follows: Changes were made to provide clarification to the wording of the rule. The word (annual) was added in the second sentence of the first paragraph.

Rule 5101:2-42-71 "Approval of Adult-Supervised Living" is amended as follows: Changes were made to reflect the new ODJFS form numbers, CDHS was stricken from the rule and changed to County Department of Job Family Services (CDJFS).

Rule 5101:2-42-96 "Phase-In For Obtaining Permanent Custody/Termination of Parental Rights". This rule is rescinded due to the five year rule review. This rule will be rescinded and will be not be replaced.
