Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-11-01, entitled <u>Independent laboratory</u>, <u>x-ray supplier</u>, and <u>independent</u> <u>diagnostic testing facility: definitions</u>, is being proposed for amendment because of the five year rule review. This rule defines laboratory services and the types of laboratories covered. The changes to the rule include clarifying language, reference to the Code of Federal Regulations, and grammatical changes that appear throughout the body of the rule.

Rule 5101:3-11-04, entitled <u>Laboratory: exceptions for FQHCs, RHCs, OHFs, and</u> <u>hospital outpatients</u>, is being proposed for amendment because of the five year rule review. This rule defines and clarifies provider procedures for FQHCs, RHCs, OHFs, and hospital outpatients. The changes to the rule include defining the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment (CLIA) and grammatical changes that appear throughout the body of the rule.

Rule 5101:3-11-05, entitled <u>Laboratory specimens sent to the Ohio department of health</u> (ODH) state laboratories, is being proposed for amendment because of the five year rule review. This rule clarifies the use of the ODH state laboratories. The changes to the rule include updating information for the CMS 1500 form and grammatical changes that appear throughout the body of the rule.

Rule 5101:3-11-06, entitled <u>Portable x-ray suppliers: covered services and limitations</u>, is being proposed for amendment because of the five year rule review. This rule explains and clarifies radiology services. The changes to the rule include grammatical changes that appear throughout the body of the rule.

Rule 5101:3-11-07, entitled <u>Independent diagnostic testing facility: coverage and</u> <u>limitations</u>, is being proposed for amendment because of the five year rule review. This rule clarifies services for independent diagnostic testing facilities. The rule explains services that are covered and the reimbursement procedures that must be followed by providers. The changes to the rule include clarifying language for tests that are covered by Medicaid and grammatical changes that appear throughout the body of the rule.
