Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code and 42 CFR 447.205, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to amend rule 5101:3-48-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Rule 5101: 3-48-01, entitled <u>Medicaid Coverage of Targeted Case Management</u> <u>Services Provided to Individuals with Mental Retardation or Developmental</u> <u>Disabilities</u> is being proposed for amendment. This rule specifies the coverable activities, the provider qualifications and the reimbursement amount and requirements for Medicaid covered targeted case management activities.

The rule changes the standard for payment by lowering the rate to that identified in the appendix to the rule. ODJFS estimates that there will be an approximate aggregate decrease in all funds (state and Federal financial participation) expenditures of \$487,500 for SFY 2007 when applying the rate in appendix A to the rule. The rate and rule are proposed for amendment based on guidance from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
