Pursuant to section 3125.25 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the rescission and adoption of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:9-7-23, entitled <u>Child Support Random Moment Sample Time Study</u>, is being proposed for rescission and replaced by a new rule with the same rule number because more than fifty percent of the current rule is being stricken, with a comparable amount of new text being added. This rule sets forth the random moment sample (RMS) methodology used to measure the activity of county child support enforcement agency (CSEA) staff related to child support program activities. Data collected from the time studies are used to calculate allocation statistics used to distribute cost pool expenditures to the appropriate programs. The percentages are used by the CSEA to distribute administrative funds.

Rule 5101:9-7-23, entitled <u>Child support random moment sample time study</u>, is being proposed for adoption to reflect the changes brought about by the implementation of a web-based random moment sampling process. All child support random moment sample (RMS) activities are now processed via webRMS, replacing the current paper process. This rule sets forth the random moment sample (RMS) methodology used to measure the activity of county child support enforcement agency (CSEA) staff related to child support program activities. Data collected from the time studies are used to calculate allocation statistics used to distribute cost pool expenditures to the appropriate programs. The percentages are used by the CSEA to distribute administrative funds. The proposed rule reflects the changes brought about by the implementation of a web-based RMS process. All child support random moment sample (RMS) activities are now processed via webRMS, replacing the current paper process.
