Pursuant to section 3125.25, and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to amend the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon due to five-year rule review.

Rule 5101:9-7-23, entitled "Child Support Random Moment Sample Time Study" sets forth the random moment sample (RMS) time study methodology used to measure the activity of county child support enforcement agency (CSEA) staff related to child support program activities. The changes to the rule include updating the time frames and quality assurance procedures for completing the RMS time study to reflect current procedures.
