Public Notice Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Proposed amendment of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-21-09, OAC rule 3745-21-10, OAC rule 3745-21-25, OAC rule 3745-21-26, OAC rule 3745-21-28, and OAC rule 3745-21-29

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) proposes to amend Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-21-09, Control of emissions of volatile organic compounds from stationary sources and perchloroethylene from dry cleaning facilities; 3745-21-10, Compliance test methods and procedures; 3745-21-25, Control of VOC emissions from reinforced plastic composites production operations; 3745-21-26, Surface coating of miscellaneous metal and plastic parts; 3745-21-28, Miscellaneous industrial adhesives and sealants; and 3745-21-29, Control of volatile organic compound emissions from automobile and light-duty truck assembly coating operations, heavier vehicle assembly coating operations, and cleaning operations associated with these coating operations. The following amendments are proposed:

- typographical and reference corrections in OAC rules 3745-21-09 and 3745-21-29;
- approval of an alternate monitoring, record keeping and reporting plan for a facility and adding an OAC rule 3745-21-29 exemption in OAC rule 3745-21-09;
- adding an OAC rule 3745-21-29 test method in OAC rule 3745-21-10;
- adding paragraph (F)(3)(c) of OAC rule 3745-21-25 as a compliant emissions estimation procedure in OAC rule 3745-21-25(F)(3);
- adding an exemption to OAC rule 3745-21-26 for sources subject to OAC rule 3745-21-25;
- revising OAC rule 3745-21-26(G)(2) to avoid confusion on record keeping and reporting requirements;
- adding a provision to OAC rule 3745-21-28 to allow for alternative limits; and,
- removing the bulk gasoline terminal loading rack testing requirements to maintain ninety per cent of the maximum throughput and at least eighty thousand gallons throughput.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the Division formally adopts them. On March 21, 2018, these rules went out for a 30-day review by interested parties.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on **Monday, January 7, 2019 at 10:30 AM** at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitor's are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

Pursuant to Part D of Title I of the Clean Air Act, Ohio EPA is required to establish a state implementation plan (SIP) for the attainment and maintenance of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The above-mentioned rules are a part of Ohio's SIP and the proposed amendments will be submitted to USEPA as a modification of the SIP. The above-mentioned hearing shall be considered the public hearing for the SIP submittal.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on January 7, 2019, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. Written statements submitted after January 7, 2019, may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.
