In a joint letter to the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review, representatives from the Ohio State Bar Association and Ohio Notary Services, noted their support for the rule's package generally, indicating that the training and testing requirements strike the right balance to ensure notaries and applicants can be appropriately educated as to what the law requires of them and in how to properly notarize a document, particularly as it relates to online notarization. The above comment is addressed in proposed rule 111:6-1-02 as it specifies that the secretary of state shall provide information on its official website to inform applicants of the authorized providers' names and contact information. This allows for easier updates as information changes and providers are added or removed from the list.
