First, many of these rules are submitted for their required five-year review under Ohio Revised Code 119. Second, several of these rules are amended to improve the equivalence of the Ohio rule with its federal counterpart provision, as amended. Ohio's hazardous waste rules are required to be equivalent to their federal counterpart provisions. Those federal provisions were changed in the following Federal Registers (FRs), and we are updating the Ohio rules accordingly.
