Proposed Rulemaking Governing
Public Water System Licenses**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Sections 6109.23, 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to amend the following rule of the Ohio Administrative Code:

3745-84-01: Definitions.

3745-84-02: Application for a license to operate or maintain a public water system.

3745-84-03: Expiration and renewal of license to operate or maintain a public water system.

3745-84-04: Format and display of license to operate or maintain a public water system.

3745-84-05: Fees for operating or maintaining a public water system.

3745-84-06: Conditioning, denial, suspension and revocation of a license to operate or maintain a public water system.

This rule addresses Public Water System License regulations.

The purpose of this rule making is to add clarification to the definition of “service connection”, update methods of contact, remove color coding language and allow shorter suspensions for corrections of violations that require less time to complete.

The public comment period will run until **Wednesday, June 5th, 2024**. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will be holding an in-person and virtual public hearing on the rules on **Wednesday, June 5th, 2024, at 10:30 AM – 11:00 AM EDT**. The in-person hearing will be at the same time and date and will be located at Ohio EPA, Suite 700, 50 W. Town Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. During the hearing, the public may submit written comments on the record about the proposed rules if participating virtually and verbally if participating in person.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rulemaking.

Written testimony should be sent to the attention of **Rylee Lane** at the Division of Drinking and Ground Water (DDAGW) P.O. Box 1049, Columbus Ohio 43216-1049. Written comments may also

be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. All testimony received at the hearing or by close of business on **Wednesday, June 5th, 2024**, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rulemaking proposal. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
