On January 22, 2013, the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board (“Board”) received the Common Sense Initiative Office’s Recommendation Memorandum (“CSI Recommendation”) for the 2013 Athletic Trainer License Eligibility Changes (OAC 4755-43-01; 4755-43-02; 4755-43-04; 4755-44-02) rule package. The Board appreciates the timely issuance of this memo.
