RE: CSI – Rule 11- Permits, Procedure Where Quota is Filled (OAC 4301:1-1-11)

On June 23, 2014, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission (“Commission”) received the Common Sense Initiative Office’s Recommendation Memorandum (“CSI Recommendation”) concerning the above-mentioned administrative rule package. The CSI Recommendation stated that “For the reasons discussed above, the CSI Office does not have any recommendations for this rule package.” The Recommendation also stated that “Based on the above comments, the CSI Office concludes that the Commission should proceed with formal filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Review.”

May this correspondence serve as our acceptance of your findings and recommendations regarding the revisions to Rule 11. The Commission will now proceed with the formal filing of this rule with JCARR. Our intent is to have the process completed by October 1, 2014.
