Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Chapter 4501-53 of the Administrative Code. The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Motorcycle Ohio, has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions. Motorcycle Ohio understands that you have no recommended changes.

By mid-February 2016, Motorcycle Ohio intends to formally file Chapter 4765-53 of the Administrative Code and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review and the Legislative Service Commission.
