**RE:** Agency Acknowledgement of CSI Review – Proposed Amended and No-Change Rules  
(OAC 4301:1-1-64, -65, -66, -67, -76, -77, -78, and -79)

On May 27, 2016, the Ohio Liquor Control Commission (“Commission”) received the Common Sense Initiative Office’s Recommendation Memorandum (“CSI Recommendation”) concerning the above-mentioned administrative rule package.
