MEMORANDUM of RESPONSE

OLDER AMERICANS ACT RULES

Thank you for reviewing ODA's proposals for OAC 173-3-01, 173-3-04, 173-3-05, 173-3-05.1, 173-3-06, 173-3-07, and 173-3-09. Because CSIO recommended ODA proceed without further amendments, ODA will file the rules with JCARR to begin the legislature's portion of the rule-review process.

Thank you for your work.

The President signed the Older Americans Act Reauthorization Act of 2016 into law the same day ODA made the original filing of the rules. Thank you for reviewing the rules again in light of the Reauthorization Act.

ODA previously informed your office that the Reauthorization Act wouldn't require any amendments to the rules other than to update the version of the Older Americans Act that many rules reference. ODA also plans to upload a revised public hearing notice for a public hearing on the same date and time and in the same location.

Because CSIO recommended that ODA proceed with the revised filings, on May 2, 2016, ODA proceeded with the revised filings.

On May 3, 2016, ODA made subsequent revised filings of OAC 173-3-05 and 173-3-07 to make technical corrections to the information listed at the end of the rule (not in the rule language itself).

For OAC173-3-05, in "replaces," ODA replaced "173-4-05" with "173-3-05." In "rule amplifies," ODA replaced "45 C.F.R. Part 75, 48 C.F.R. Subpart 2.1, or 2 C.F.R. Parts 300 (October, 2015 edition)" with "2 C.F.R. Part 300 (January, 2016 edition); 45 C.F.R. Part 75 and 48 C.F.R. Subpart 2.1 (October, 2015 edition)". For OAC173-3-07, in "prior effective date," ODA replaced a semi-colon with a period. These technical corrections did not change the adverse impact of the rule or ODA's estimate of the adverse impact in the BIA.
