On July 24, 2018, the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”) received the Common Sense Initiative Office’s Recommendation Memorandum (“CSI Recommendation”) for the Skill-Based Amusement Machine Key Employee Licensing package. The Commission thanks the CSI Office for their review and recommendation on the rule package.

The CSI Recommendation stated that “the CSI Office does not have any recommendations for this rule package... [T]he CSI Office concludes that the Ohio Casino Control Commission should proceed with the formal filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.”

Subsequent to submitting proposed amended rule 3772-50-05 to the CSI Office, the Commission has lowered the application and licensing fees two \$25 respectively. At this time, the Commission plans to move forward with the original filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review, including the fee reduction.
