Dear Mr. Ritzenthaler:

Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Chapter 4765-6 (*EMT Curriculums*) of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions.

In early January 2019, the Division of EMS intends to formally file O.A.C. Chapter 4765-6 and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR), the Ohio Legislative Service Commission, and the Secretary of State. Rule 4765-6-01, which was submitted to CSI as an amended rule, will be submitted to JCARR as a no change rule, because the email address does not require revision, as we originally thought.

The Division of EMS plans to conduct a public hearing pursuant to Revised Code 119.03 in February 2019. The Division of EMS anticipates final-filing the rules with an approximate effective date in April 2019.
