Subject: CSI Review – 2021 Coal Rules

Thank you for your thorough review and analysis of the Division of Mineral Resources Management's (DMRM's) 2021 coal rules. The Common Sense Initiative (CSI) review memorandum states that these rules cover DMRM's regulations regarding coal mining and reclamation requirements, such as record keeping, permits to mine coal, permit applications, plans and mapping, performance security requirements, liability insurance, exploration standards, protection standards, inspections and use of lands. CSI has no recommendations on this rules package. CSI concluded that the Ohio Department of Natural Resources should proceed with filing the rules with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.
